FISHING REGULATIONS

COLES LAKE : General freshwater fishing regulations apply

- **5 fish per day / per person**
- **bring out 2 day limit (10 fish)**

STREAMS : only single barbless hooks
only **2 fish over 30 cm (12 in.)**

FISHING TIPS

COLES LAKE - LITTLE COLES LAKE - GOOSE LAKE

- all lakes offer excellent fly-fishing, trolling, spin-casting.
- Rainbow trout up to 3 lbs.- great fighters - feed on fresh water shrimp
- any variety of small flies work well for fly-fishing and spinning gear with small lures for spin-casting and trolling.

Flies: Doc Spratley - Pheasant Tail Nymph - Woolly Bugger - Royal Coachman
Sink tip (10-15 ft. Down) any leech pattern - usual trout flies

Lures: Spinning gear- small spinners & flat fish - brass or silver crocodiles, etc.

- trolling around the islands always proves successful

Excellent fly-fishing at the west end of Coles Lake, at the mouth of the creek.
You can wade in the shallows or cast from shore. Or anchor the boat and cast
(the boats have floors)

Always great fishing around the islands and the mouths of creeks and streams.

LITTLE COLES LAKE - we have a 17 ft. canoe - spectacular mountain scenery and fishing.

GOOSE LAKE - (15 min. easy walk) from east end of Coles.

We have a canoe, so you can fish Goose Lk. or canoe up to the top end and wade (bring your hip waders) in Coles creek from some great fly-fishing. Lots of pools to choose from.
